Babasaheb, the Voice of the Marginalised

Remembering Dr. Ambedkar on his Birth Anniversary

Babasaheb Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar was a trailblazer for his role in altering the contours of the Indian society and modern history. He was a legal expert, anthropologist, economic expert, political & social scientist, polyglot orator, editor, journalist and reformer who played a key role in the country's freedom movement and the drafting of its Constitution. His repudiation of age-old hegemonic social practices earned him the title of Champion of the 'depressed and marginalised sects' including women.

Early Life

Dr. Ambedkar was born into a Mahar family on April 14, 1891, which was considered to be of a lower caste in those days. His father Ramji Maloji Sakpal shaped his mind and personality. His mother Bhimabai Murbadkar died in 1896 due to physical ailments.

In 1900, Ambedkar was admitted to a Government School in Satara, where his teacher Krishnaji Keshav Ambedkar altered his family name from Ambavadekar to Ambedkar.

In 1904, his entire family migrated to Mumbai to reside in Dabak Chawl and he joined the Elphinstone High School. In 1908, he enrolled himself in the Elphinstone College, Mumbai. Ambedkar performed exceptionally well in his academics, but the segregation and discrimination he encountered troubled him most. He was among the first people belonging to the 'depressed and backward descent' to enrol in a college in India.

Ambedkar married Ramabai, a nine-year-old Dapoli girl in 1908. Ramabai gave him moral support while he



pursued a higher education. In 1911, Maharaja Sayajirao Gaekwad-III of Baroda sanctioned a scholarship of Rs 25 per month for his graduation. In 1912, Dr Ambedkar received his Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree on Economics and Political Science from Elphinstone College, Bombay University. On January 15, 1913, Dr. Ambedkar was appointed as Probationer in Military Department's Accountant General Office, Baroda. He became Financial Secretary of the Baroda State with salary of Rs 75 per

month. Due to humiliation faced at work Ambedkar left the job.

On April 04, 1913, Ambedkar received a special financial assistance to pursue higher education of 11.5 Pounds per month for two years. On July 20, 1913, he got admitted to Columbia University, New York, USA.

When he authored his essay on "Castes in India: Their Mechanism, Origin, and Development", he was only 24 (1917), and was mentored by veteran anthro-pologist Alexander Golden-weiser. He argued against various academically inclined authors who had previously written on caste in this ground-breaking work. Dr. Ambedkar was upset by the discrimination in his life in 1917 after returning to his job as a military secretary for the Baroda State.

He left his job, and took up to work as a private tutor and accountant and even launched his own consulting firm. In 1918, he was appointed a Professor in Sydenham College, Mumbai with a salary of Rs 450 per month. However, on 15th March 1920, he resigned. On July 05, 1920, he again returned to London to complete his advance studies (partly with the financial aid from Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj of Kolhapur).

In 1920, he received the degree of Barrister-at-Law from Gray's Inn, London. In 1921, he was awarded M.Sc. degree by the London University for his work titled, "Provincial Decentralisation of Imperial Finance in British India". From 1922 to 23, he spent some time reading Economics at the University of Bonn in Germany. Later, in

IAS (Prelims) Examination

The Right Approach

Every year the UPSC (Union Public Service Commission) publishes its notification for the Civil Services Examination which also includes three prestigious services, viz; the IAS, IPS, and the IFS, apart from number of allied central services like the income tax, customs, audit and accounts and many more. Getting a government job has always been a preferred choice for the youth in India due to the social prestige, job security, good perks attached to these jobs. Lakhs of candidates from all kinds of educational backgrounds-humanities, engineering management, agriculture, and medical science, apply for this examination conducted by UPSC every year. The whole examination process consisting of three stages of exam, i.e., prelims, mains, and interview, is completed in fifteen months from the date of UPSC notification. The eligibility criteria has been kept very simple with a view to ensure participation by large



number of candidates and making the exam inclusive in nature. Any graduate in any discipline with just 35% marks is eligible to apply. The age criteria is also very liberal. For general category candidates, it is 21-32 years with a maximum of six attempts while for the OBC it is 35 years with nine attempts. For SC/STs, the upper age limit is 37 years with unlimited attempts. It is to be noted that appearing in the prelims will be counted as an attempt irrespective of your

results. Also, if you fail at any stage of the exam, you have to start the race from the beginning. This makes the civil services exam very demanding and takes its toll in terms of mental and physical health of the candidates. This has been pointed out by the latest report of a parliamentary

committee on civil services examination which has recommended reducing the time consumed in completing the entire examination process from the existing fifteen months to six months. The point is; this is not just an exam of knowledge, but also of your patience, perseverance and attitude. It is impossible to succeed in this exam without the right attitude. Just covering the syllabus is not the only demand this exam places on the students. All your qualities of courage, optimism, patience are put to test. This is so because, given the tough nature of the exam, it takes more than one attempt (barring rare exceptions) to finally make it. Only those who are mentally and psychologically prepared to withstand the pressure can kiss

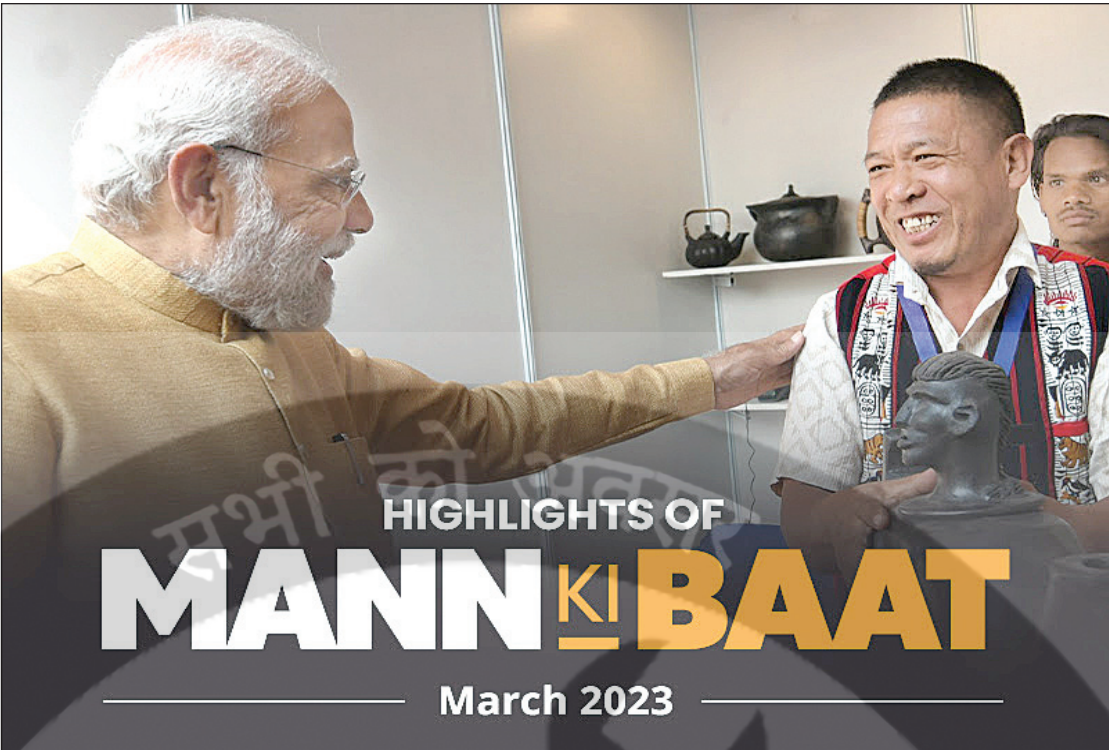
Inviting Suggestions for 100 Episode

Women Power: Giving Energy



to India's Dreams

It is Navratri, the auspicious time to worship the divine feminine energy, Shakti. As India emerges with new potential, I acknowledge the vital role played by our women power. We have witnessed many recent examples of their outstanding achievements. Asia's first female loco pilot, Surekha Yadav, made history by becoming the first woman to drive Vande Bharat Express. Producer Guneet Monga and director Kartiki Gonsalves won an Oscar for their documentary, 'The Elephant Whisperers', and Sister Jyotirmayi Mohanty of Bhabha Atomic Research Center was awarded a special recognition in the field of Chemistry and Chemical Engineering by IUPAC. India's Under-19 women's cricket team made us proud by winning the T-20 World Cup, while Nagaland witnessed a historic moment when two women legislators were elected to the Vidhan Sabha, and one of them became a minister in the government of Nagaland. I had the privilege of meeting the brave daughters of India who went to help the people of Turkey after the devastating earthquake. Our daughters are now raising the flag of their bravery in all three armed forces.

Group Captain Shalija Dhami, with a flying experience of about 3000 hours, has become the first woman Air Force officer to get a Command Appointment in a Combat Unit. Meanwhile, Captain Shiva Chauhan of the Indian Army has become the first woman officer to be posted at Siachen, where the temperature drops to minus sixty (-60) degrees. This list is only a small representation of the many inspiring stories of women who are giving energy to India and India's dreams. Women power is the oxygen of a developed India, and I am proud to witness this energy as it drives us towards a brighter future.

Sabka Prayas Driving India's Solar Mission Forward

For centuries, the people of India have had a special relationship with the Sun, and our scientific understanding of its power and traditions of worshipping it are rarely seen elsewhere. I am delighted that every Indian now understands the importance of solar energy and wants to contribute to clean energy. This spirit of 'Sabka Prayas' is driving India's Solar Mission forward. In Pune, Maharashtra, the people of MSR-Olive Housing Society have decided to run all common utilities such as drinking water,

lift, and lights in the society using solar energy alone. After installing solar panels, they are now generating around 90 thousand kilowatt hours of electricity every year, resulting in savings of about Rs 40,000 per month. Similarly, Diu has become the first district in India to use 100% clean energy for all daytime needs. The mantra of their success is also 'Sabka Prayas.' The people of Diu installed solar panels on barren land and buildings, generating more electricity than required during the daytime. This solar project has saved about Rs 52 crore on electricity purchases and has significantly helped the environment.

Saurashtra-Tamil Sangamam: Another Manifestation of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat

A few months ago, a tradition began in Kashi that celebrated the historical and cultural ties between Kashi and the Tamil region during the Kashi-Tamil Sangamam. As we celebrate the 400th birth anniversary of Veer Lachit Borphukan ji, I want to highlight the brave warrior's role in liberating Guwahati from the Mughal Sultanate's clutches. It's heartening to see that the country is getting acquainted with his indomitable courage. Recently, a campaign for essay writing based on the life of Lachit Borphukan was launched, and I am proud to announce that about 45 lakh people sent essays for this initiative. It has now become a Guinness Record, which is a significant achievement. I am delighted to share that these essays were written in about 23 different languages, including Hindi, English, Bangla, Bodo, Nepali, Sanskrit, and Santhali, apart from Assamese. It fills my heart with gratitude and appreciation for everyone who has been a part of this effort.

Lotus Stem and Lavender Changing the Face of Farming in Kashmir


When we think of Kashmir or Srinagar, we usually picture its valleys and the beautiful Dal Lake. We all desire to witness the breathtaking views of Dal Lake. However, there is something else that makes Dal Lake special, and that is its delicious Lotus Stems, locally known as 'Kamal Kakdi' or Nadru. Kashmir's Nadru is in high demand, and in response to this, a group of around 250 farmers cultivating Nadru in Dal Lake have formed an FPO (Farmers' Producer Organisation) to meet this demand. These farmers have started exporting their Nadru to foreign countries and have already sent two consignments to UAE. This achievement not only brings recognition to Kashmir but also enhances the income of numerous farmers. Furthermore, I would like to share another success story related to agriculture in Kashmir. The farmers in the town of Bhadarwah in the Doda district have traditionally cultivated maize for decades, but some of them decided to venture into floriculture, particularly lavender cultivation. Today, around two and a half thousand farmers are growing lavender, and the Aroma Mission of the Central Government has supported them in this endeavor. This new cultivation has significantly increased the farmers' income, and the fragrance of their success is spreading far and wide.

Babasaheb, the Voice of the Marginalised

1923, he received a D.Sc. from the London School of Economics, on his seminal work titled "The Problem of the Rupee: Its Origin and its Solution". In the same year, Dr. Ambedkar published another book with the title "The Evolution of Provincial Finance in British India: A Study in the Provincial Decentralisation of Imperial Finance" (with a preface from Prof. Seligman) as his doctoral thesis at Columbia. In 1927, he was formally awarded the Ph.D. degree by Columbia University. In 1935, Dr. Ambedkar was appointed Principal of the Government Law College, Bombay, a position he held for two years. Apart from this, due to his role as the Chief Architect of the Indian Constitution, he received an L.L.D (Honoris Causa) in 1952 from Columbia University, New York along with a D.Litt. (Honoris Causa) in 1953 from Osmania University, Hyderabad. Both of these degrees echoed his real-time achievements, and leadership in compiling the Constitution of India in 2 years, 18 months, and 17 days by studying and reviewing the Constitutions of around 60 countries. Dr. Ambedkar is also credited with establishing Milind College (1950) in Aurangabad and Siddhartha College (1946) in Bombay. Dr. Ambedkar claimed that, "the aim of the human society must be to enable every person to lead a life of culture which means the cultivation of the mind as distinguished from the satisfaction of mere physical wants".

Mahasankalp/Great Resolution

On September 23, 1917, after the harrowing experience of forceful defenestration at Parsi inn, Dr. Ambedkar became resolute to alter the way depressed and backward sects were treated in India. Mahasankalp Diwas or Great Resolution Day is now observed annually as a tribute to Babasaheb Dr. Ambedkar's contributions to Indian society and his struggle for the rights of the marginalised.

This day is also an opportunity to reflect on his vision of creating an equal and just society, and to pledge to carry forward his legacy by working towards promoting equality, justice, and human rights for all. This year it would be the 105 years of Mahasankalp (Great Resolution) taken by Babasaheb Dr. Ambedkar while sitting under a tree at Kamathi Baug or Sayaji

Baug, which is located in Baroda, Gujarat. Dr. Ambedkar Foundation, on behalf of the Government of India, is striving to spread the visions of Babasaheb Dr. Ambedkar through various schemes in India and in abroad.

Role in Nation Building

Babasaheb Dr. Ambedkar is considered as an economist extraordinaire. Reserve Bank of India (RBI) Act (which was passed on March 06, 1934) was envisioned according to the guiding principle put forward by Dr. Ambedkar to the Hilton Young Commission in his seminal work titled "The Problem of the Rupee: Its Origin and Its Solution" (1923).

In terms of labour reforms, as a member of labour in the viceroy's council from 1942 to 1946, Babasaheb Dr. Ambedkar played a key role in carrying out numerous labour reforms which was the need of the hour. During the seventh session of the Indian Labour Conference, held in New Delhi in November, 1942, he reduced the working day from 12 to 8 hours. The Dearness Allowance, Leave Benefits, Employee Insurance, Medical Leave, Equal Pay for Equal Work, Minimum Wages, and Periodic Revision of the Scale of Pay are just a few of the measures he also enacted for workers. Moreover, Babasaheb Dr. Ambedkar promoted labour unions and started employment exchanges on a pan-Indian scale.

Apart from this, Damodar Valley Project, the Bhakhra Nangal Dam Project, the Son River Valley Project, and the Hirakund Dam Project were all started by Dr. Ambedkar, who is also credited with being the inventor of multipurpose river valley projects in India. In order to expedite the construction of irrigation projects at the Central and State levels, he also formed the Central Water Commission. Dr. Ambedkar also formed the Central Technical Power Board and Central Electricity Authority to investigate the feasibility of and to establish hydel and thermal power stations in order to jump-start the growth of India's power sector. He also underlined the requirement for an Indian grid system (which the country still uses) and for qualified electrical engineers.

Post Independence, Dr. Ambedkar was allocated the Law Ministry in 1947 but he resigned from this post as a sign of protest when the comprehensive Hindu Code Bill

was dropped by the then Indian Parliament. The bill's two main goals were to end caste and social inequality and to raise the social standing of Hindu women by granting them their due rights. He observed that, "I measure the progress of a community by the degree of progress which women have achieved".

For his contributions in nation-building, he was conferred with the Bharat Ratna award on March 31, 1990, posthumously which was received by his wife Dr. Savita Ambedkar.

Embracing Buddhism

In 1956, Dr. Ambedkar had publicly converted to Buddhism, along with followers, in a movement known as Navayana Buddhism which was held in Nagpur. Bhante Chandramani, a Buddhist monk initiated Dr. Ambedkar into Buddhism, and called him "the modern Buddha of this age". Dr. Ambedkar embraced Buddhism because he saw it as a way of life to escape the graded hierarchy faced by the depressed and

backward sects due to prevalent hegemonic practices.

In the current context, Navayana, also known as Neo-Buddhism, is a term which was coined by Dr. Ambedkar. This was a means to describe his reinterpretation of Buddhism. Dr. Ambedkar saw Buddhism as a means of breaking free from the caste system and achieving social equality. He argued that the original teachings of the Buddha were distorted over time by the caste system, and therefore he proposed a new, more liberal and democratic interpretation of Buddhism that rejected the caste system and emphasised equality and justice.

Dr. Ambedkar believed that the teachings of the Gautam Buddha offered a path to liberation and equality and that the caste system and other forms of discrimination had corrupted the original teachings of Buddhism in India. He also saw Buddhism as a way to unite the depressed and backward community and promote social justice. Dr. Ambedkar wrote a book called

"The Buddha and His Dhamma" (1957), in which he interpreted the teachings of the Buddha in the context of modern India and argued for their relevance to social and political issues.



IAS (Prelims) Examination: The Right Approach

success at last. During the run from the start to finish many challenges viz; disappointments, depression, mental and physical fatigue are bound to challenge you. Keeping in mind what all it takes to make it to the civil services is, thus, the first good step taken towards success.

It is pertinent to understand the different stages of the civil services exam and prepare as per its purpose. The preliminary examination is a qualifying test for Mains to filter out a few thousand candidates from a crowd of lakhs of applicants. It is a qualifying exam because you just need to achieve the cut off marks to be eligible for the main exam and its marks are not counted in your final success. Your final success and rank will be based on your performance in the main exam and the interview, not the preliminary exam. But it is the most crucial part of the exam in the sense that it opens the door for you for the next level of exam. Under the existing scheme of exam, the prelims consist of two papers. One is the CSAT (Civil Services Aptitude Test) paper which comprises English comprehension, verbal reasoning and numerical ability. In order to fetch the minimum 33% marks in this paper; one has to familiarise with all the three sections of its syllabus rather than relying on only one or two. The second paper is known as General Studies (GS), which is made up of a number of disciplines. The core disciplines in the GS paper comprise: history, polity, geography and economy. In addition, there are questions on science and technology and current affairs. Here again, one has to have command all the sections rather than covering the syllabus in a lop sided manner.

The preliminary examination has increasingly become the toughest and most unpredictable part of the exam for a variety of reasons. First, out of five-six lakh candidates appearing for it, only ten-twelve thousand qualify in the prelims. Second, the CSAT paper, which tests

English comprehension and reasoning and numerical ability, though a qualifying paper requiring just 33% of marks to qualify, is becoming a hurdle for many candidates nowadays as the difficult questions have been increased. Earlier, CSAT was taken for granted by most candidates. Third, the nature of questions in the GS paper is difficult to predict because, UPSC continuously experiments with the questions and brings new types of questions every year to take the candidate by surprise. Fourth, the negative marking makes the prelims highly risky. If you do not use prudence and go on attempting all the questions, chances are that you will get very low marks because of the negative marking. Finally, time is a big constraint in the prelims exam as you have to attempt 100 questions in the GS and 80 questions in the CSAT paper within two hours allotted to each of these two papers. Thus, you get just a little more than one minute for attempting one question which includes some very long questions also.

How much time should be devoted for prelims exam preparation? For the first timers, the safe period to command the prelims syllabus is 8-10 months. This is so because, one has to read some core, standard books for five six disciplines, make notes, revise the syllabus at least twice and then to appear in multiple mock tests. One should never appear in the prelims exam without complete preparation which is bound to take 8-10 months. However, for those who have already appeared in the prelims exam, earlier, the preparation period obviously gets reduced to 3-4 months as they have gone through the entire syllabus in their previous attempt. Such candidates should focus more on the mains rather than reading what they already know.

How to read and what to read? It is always good to read from standard books and authentic sources rather than blindly following unverified material flooding in the market and cheaply available online.


Without self- reading of important text books, you can never develop a clear understanding of the basic concepts. The online sources or the materials flooding in the market largely fail to deliver on conceptual aspect and emphasize on information overload which is not required at all. Therefore, you have to be very selective in choosing what you are reading and what the reliability of these sources is. The same is true of the self-styled experts who have mushroomed in the market. Unless you are sure of whom they are, what their proven academic credentials are, you cannot rely on them on their face value. You must be sure that your mentor is capable, devoted to your cause and a man of integrity. As for reading style, you must define your boundaries and never go for indiscriminate reading as it would become a never ending exercise. In other words, you must have the knack to decide what to read and what to leave on a topic, because neither you have the time to read everything available, nor it is required. Once you have known the basic fundamentals of an issue, you have to stop there and move to the next one. Or else, you will never do justice to the entire syllabus. Making notes is utterly important while reading. These notes will become handy during revision. You may keep adding new information to these notes if you come across any. Finally, you must read very close to the prescribed syllabus rather than exceeding its boundaries. UPSC has given the contours of the prelims syllabus in its notification and you must follow it. In fact, you should make a detailed syllabus of your own as the one provided by UPSC is only indicative in nature. For this, the best way is to peruse last years' questions asked on a particular area and then to include those areas in your preparation. A dynamic, intelligent approach to the syllabus is what is going to work for you.

How to prepare current affairs? Current affairs constitute the backbone of the civil services exam. They have a bearing on all the three parts of the exam-prelims, mains and the interview. The real challenge for a candidate is how to


command current affairs that includes everything under the sun. The simple answer to this question is: read and read from a variety of sources such as national newspapers, journals, magazines, government sites, sites of organisations such as UNO, WTO, G20 and so on. In every static portion, current affairs will count. In geography and environment, you must know the latest news on earthquakes, climate change, pollution etc. In economy, you must know about the budget, export imports and so on. In polity, you must know about the latest Bills, Acts, Supreme Court judgments etc. Emphasis on current affairs must be given from the very outset and on daily basis. Again, the compiled materials on current affairs are of least relevance as they fail to make you grasp the events and issues in their entirety. It is therefore, highly recommendable that you should grasp current affairs from direct sources-newspapers, magazines etc.

Success mantra for prelims: Since the prelims syllabus is made up of a variety of disciplines, it is prudent to take up one discipline at a time. Therefore, you should take up one subject, say polity, and read it intensively in all respects within a time frame. For beginners each of the discipline will require two months of intensive preparation preferably under a competent, personal mentor. However, simultaneous preparation of current affairs is required as it is newspaper based and you cannot neglect daily reading of news. Previous questions of UPSC are available on its website. You should solve at least last 15 years' questions asked in prelims exam. This will be more helpful than an outside test series because, this way, you will be answering questions of UPSC type, not imaginary type often set in the market which often does not meet UPSC standards. Each area of the prelims syllabus requires separate analysis, which will be covered in the forthcoming articles.



Water is the planet's most precious resource. The COVID-19 pandemic also paved way for the use of fresh water, as it is essential to wash our hands with water to prevent the disease. So, in order to promote the responsible use and access to safe water for everyone, World Water Day is observed on March 22 each year since 1993, to highlight the importance of fresh water. Here, are some water conservation technologies used in my region to save fresh water:


- ECO365's Aerators:** It is also called as pipe nozzle fittings, which was found only in green buildings are very common in large communities along the Old Mahabalipuram Road (OMR) nowadays. The average tap releases around 12-15 litres of water per minute but the ECO365's aerators cut this to three litres by reducing water flow pressure.
- ECOMIST:** Fitting these smart nozzles in cafeterias and rest rooms helps to reduce the flow of water to a mist by atomising the water into droplets of water and brings down water consumption by 80% and prevents wastage of water.

Technology used in my home to save water:

IoT- powered smart water meters: When attached to inlets, this technology helps us detect the amount of water flow in real time. It also gives us a detailed consumption report along with other metrics which are shared through mobile app to us.

News Digest

NATIONAL

■ India Unveils Dynamic Foreign Trade Policy with Long-Term Focus

India has unveiled its much-awaited Foreign Trade Policy, breaking with tradition by adopting a "long-term" focus instead of the usual five-year policy. The new policy seeks to make the Indian Rupee a global currency and allow international trade settlement in the domestic currency. The policy aims to boost exports, with Union Minister Piyush Goyal announcing plans for a massive outreach globally in the next four months. The focus will shift from incentives to a remission and entitlement-based regime, with benefits extended to e-commerce exports estimated to grow to US \$200-300 billion by 2030. The value limit for exports through courier services will be increased from Rs 5 lakh to Rs 10 lakh per consignment. Faridabad, Moradabad, Mirzapur and Varanasi have been declared as towns of export excellence, and an amnesty scheme for a one-time settlement of default in export obligation has been introduced. The policy will also automate some trade approvals and cut charges for medium-sized and small businesses to secure some government-backed benefits.

■ Second Meeting of G20 Startup Engagement Group Concludes in Sikkim

Startup20, a newly formed engagement group within the G20, representing the global startup ecosystem, held its second meeting in Gangtok, Sikkim on 18th and 19th March 2023. The event saw participation from over 300 dignitaries, including G20 members and invitee countries, national delegates, and international organisations. The Sikkim Sabha was inaugurated by dignitaries who gave keynote addresses, including the Chief Minister of Sikkim, Shri Prem Singh Tamang, and the Minister of State for Commerce and Industry, Shri Som Prakash. The event featured discussions on a draft policy paper and presentations from the three task-forces: Foundation and Alliances, Finance, and Inclusion and Sustainability. The final summit of Startup20 will take place in Gurugram in July.



■ Digital Public Infrastructure Biggest Administrative Reform: I&B Secretary

Successful implementation of Digital Public Infrastructure platforms in the country was the biggest administrative change the country has witnessed in the past 75 years. Speaking to media persons at Kumarkom, where the 2nd Sherpa Meeting of the G20 Summit under India's Presidency was held, Secretary, Ministry of Information & Broadcasting Shri Apurva Chandra said the Digital Public Infrastructure has been showcased at the Digital Experience Zone created by NASSCOM at a side event organised as part of the Sherpa Meet. Earlier, India's Sherpa Amitabh Kant inaugurated a side event on Digital Public Infrastructure, by lighting the traditional ceremonial lamp. Infosys co-founder Nandan Nilekani, EU Commissioner for Internal Market Thierry Breton, DIAL Community MD Priya Vora were among those who addressed the delegates.

■ Three New Resources under AIM Launched to Empower Young Minds

NITI Aayog has launched three new resources to promote innovation and creativity among young people in the country as part of Atal Innovation Mission (AIM). The resources launched include the ATL Tinkering Curriculum, the Equipment Manual, and the Calendar of Activities for 2023-24. The ATL Tinkering Curriculum is a structured program for hands-on learning in areas ranging from basic electronics and mechanics to cutting-edge technologies like 3D printing and the Internet of Things. The Equipment Manual offers comprehensive guidance on the equipment provided in Atal Tinkering Labs. The Calendar of Activities for 2023-24 outlines a year-long schedule of events, workshops, and competitions aimed at promoting innovation and entrepreneurship among students. With these resources, teachers, mentors, and students across India will have access to the tools and skills necessary to innovate for a better future.

■ MoD Signs Multiple Contracts with Indigenous Defence Companies for Procuring Critical Weapons

Ministry of Defence has signed contracts worth over Rs 19,600 crore with Indian shipyards for the acquisition of 11 Next Generation Offshore Patrol Vessels and six Next Generation Missile Vessels, as part of the country's efforts to achieve 'Aatmanirbharta' in defence. The contract for the offshore patrol vessels was signed with Goa Shipyard Ltd and Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers, while Cochin Shipyard Limited received the contract for the missile vessels. The Defence Ministry has also signed a contract with BrahMos Aerospace Private Limited (BAPL) for procurement of Next Generation Maritime Mobile Coastal Batteries (long-range) and BrahMos Missiles at an approximate cost of over Rs 1,700 crore under Buy (Indian) Category. The delivery of the systems is scheduled to commence from 2027. Meanwhile, the ministry has entered into a contract with Bharat Dynamics Limited for the procurement of improved AWS worth over Rs 8,160 crore.

■ Gas Regulatory Board Introduces Unified Tariff under 'One Nation, One Grid, One Tariff'

The Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) has announced a major reform in the natural gas sector in India, with the aim of achieving the ambitious goal of One Nation, One Grid and One Tariff. As part of this reform, the PNGRB has issued a notification for levelised Unified Tariffs, which comes into effect from 1st April 2023. The levelised unified tariff of Rs 73.93 per MBTU (Metric Million British Thermal Unit) will be implemented as per three tariff zones in the entire gas network of the country. The first tariff zone will be reckoned up to 300 Kms from gas source, the second is 300 km to 1200 km, and the third zone is beyond 1200 km from the gas source. The implementation of levelised Unified Tariffs is expected to simplify the gas pricing structure in the country and promote transparency in the natural gas sector.

INTERNATIONAL

■ US Judge Rules H-1B Visa Holders' Spouse Can Work in the US

US District Judge Tanya Chutkan has dismissed a lawsuit filed by Save Jobs USA, which sought to revoke the Obama-era regulation that allowed spouses of certain

categories of H-1B visa holders to work in the US. The decision brings a big relief to foreign workers in the US technology sector, as it allows their spouses to work and support their families, even as Save Jobs USA plans to appeal against the ruling. Tech giants like Amazon, Apple, Google, and Microsoft had opposed the lawsuit. The US has issued nearly 100,000 work authorisations to spouses of H-1B workers so far. The H-1B visa is widely used by US companies, particularly in the technology sector, to employ foreign workers in specialty occupations that require theoretical or technical expertise.



■ 25 SCO Countries Agree to Collaborate on Promoting Traditional Medicines

25 countries from the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) have agreed to collaborate on promoting e traditional medicine and contribute to economic development, environment protection, and health security. The consensus was reached at during the B2B Conference & Expo and National Arogya Summit held in Guwahati under India's presidency of the SCO. The event witnessed the active participation of Myanmar and Maldives health ministers and technical sessions by China, Russia, and Pakistan through virtual mode. The conference was attended by a total of 214 participants, including 83 international delegates from 16 SCO countries and 131 Indian delegates. The B2B expo involved 56 exhibitors and received trade interest from 13 SCO countries in the fields of Ayurveda Education, Traditional Medicine Products, and developing Infrastructure for providing Ayurveda and Yoga for Medical Value Travel.

ECONOMY

■ India's Overall Exports Touches All Time High of US\$ 750 Billion

Union Minister of Commerce and Shri Piyush Goyal has announced that India's overall exports, including services and merchandise exports, have surpassed US\$ 750 billion, a new all-time high. The announcement comes as India celebrates the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on its 75th year of independence. Noting that India's exports was \$500 billion in 2020-2021, the minister praised the Free Trade Agreements (FTA) signed by India with Australia and UAE, which have been welcomed by industry across the three countries, and stated that a series of FTAs are under different stages of discussion to further expand India's trade and open up game-changing opportunities for the economy. He stated that this is India's moment in the Sun, and the G20 presidency gives a unique opportunity to position India globally, which must be leveraged by the industry and businesspersons to showcase India's business across the world.

■ 19 Companies Onboarded for Captive Employment Initiative

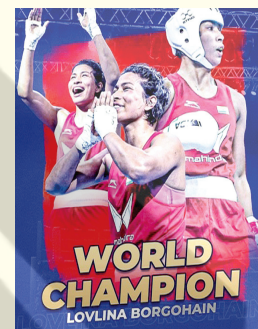
Union Minister for Rural Development, Shri Giriraj Singh, announced the onboarding of 19 Captive Employers under the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY) in New Delhi on 28th March 2023. The initiative aims to train rural poor youth and provide them with employment opportunities within the company or its subsidiaries. In the first phase, the selected Captive Employers will provide training to 31,000 rural youth in industries such as hospitality, apparel & textiles, manufacturing, IT/ITeS, telecom, retail, and power. The initiative is a shot in the arm for the DDU-GKY programme, assuring post-training placement of candidates for a minimum of six months with a minimum CTC of Rs 10,000/-. This program will be a big boon for rural poor to augment their job needs and improve their standard of living. This program shall also contribute to sustainable development goals.



SPORTS

■ India Score 4 Gold in World Women's Boxing Championship

Nikhat Zareen has become the second Indian woman boxer after Mary Kom to bag more than one world titles. Women's World Boxing Championships in New Delhi, 26 year old Nikhat created history as she defeated Vietnam's Nguyen Thi Tam in the 50 light fly weight category. India wrapped up World Boxing Championships with four gold medals. While Tokyo Olympic bronze medallist Lovlina Borgohain won her maiden World Championships gold by defeating Caitlin Parker of Australia in the final of the middleweight 75 kilogram category, Nitu Ghanghas and Saweety Boora also won two gold medals for the country.



■ Indian Pair Win Swiss Open Super 300 Badminton Doubles Title

India's top men's doubles badminton pair of Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty won their first title of the 2023 season in Basel beating China's Ren Xiang Yu and Tan Qiang 21-19, 24-22 in the Swiss Open 2023, a Super 300 event. The world number 6 pair beat the world number 21 pair in a little under an hour. This was Rankireddy and Shetty's first BWF (Badminton World Federation) doubles title of the year, and the fifth World Tour title in their career.
